This year, the East Penn Youth Wrestling League will be sponsoring a team to attend the Wildwood National Duals. We will be wrestling in the elementary division (Grades 2-6, maximum age 12 years old as of December 31, 2014). Hopefully this will be the first of many to follow.

This dual team is open to all East Penn Wrestlers and spots will be determined through wrestle off's & invitation that will be completed by mid December. Wrestle off's will be held 381 Nina Way in Warminster, PA 18974 at a date TBD shortly. (Other locations may used at the discretion of coaching staff if needed) The roster will be 16 wrestlers (1 wrestler @ each weight class plus 2 alternates). The weight classes are the following:

50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100, 105, 115, 150

*There will be no weight allowance.* If interested, make sure that you can maintain the weight you are submitting through February.
